

Jump and Splash Camp 2019 Information

Date: August 1st-4th, 2019

We are looking forward to a great camp!! The cost for camp this year will be \$415. The fee for campers includes their food, stabling, 2 bags of shavings, camping and instruction.

We have a fantastic instructor lined up, Judy McHerron, a local National Examiner from our Region. If numbers of camp participants permit we will bring on a second instructor as well!

Jump and Splash Camp is focused on Unrated through C-1 level instruction, though members holding higher certifications and adult members are welcome to join in the fun too. Campers under 18 must have a designated chaperone.

Most of the campers bring tents. You may bring an RV for an extra cost. Eventful Acres has a few RV's that they rent...contact Karen at 530-692-0919. There are showers and flush toilets as well as several porta-potties.

All campers are stabled by their ride group. So you might not be able to be stabled next to a friend! But this is a great way to get to know members from other parts of the region. Arrival time is 3:00 to 7:00pm on Thursday. **NO riding or lunging of horses is allowed on Thursday.** Dinner will be at 7PM on Thursday with an orientation meeting following dinner. Campers, chaperones and parents **must** be at the orientation meeting. Additional shavings may be purchased for \$10 a bag or you may bring your own. Please bring cash if you are purchasing additional shavings.

Location: Eventful Acres, 9594 Yuba Ranch Way, Oregon House, CA

Instruction: Campers will ride twice each day, one flat and one cross-country lesson. Campers are NOT required to jump and are welcome to participate in flat lessons only. In addition to riding, there will be Arts and Crafts and horse management lessons as well. We will have a fun, mounted activity on Monday.

Adult volunteers: We always need help for activities during the day. For horse savvy parents we need help with safety checks. Parents are always welcome to watch lessons, help provide water, take pictures, etc. They may not interfere with the lesson or cause distractions for the instructor or riders.

The undersigned Owner/Rider/Student/Parent or Guardian shall hold Eventful Acres, Rod and Karen Hisken, employee their agents or family members harmless from all damages or liability for and injury to person, injury to horse, damage to personal property or for wrongful injury or death caused by negligence.

3. The undersigned Owner/Rider/Student/Parent or Guardian does for him/herself, his/her heirs, executors, administrators, an assigns hereby release, waive, discharge and relinquish any action or cause of action, aforesaid, which may hereafter arise for him/herself and for his/her estate and agrees that under any claim for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death against Rod Hisken, Karen Hisken, employee, their agents or any family member for any of said cause of action, whether the same shall arise by negligence of any person otherwise. Camper Packing List – Please label everything!!

Temperature may range from the mid-80's degrees during the day to 40's degrees during the night. Campers must have clean riding clothes each day. Please put your name and club name on all items clearly! Add in any other necessities.

Riding Clothes:

- Breeches
- Polo shirts – **NO Sleeveless, spaghetti straps or belly shirts allowed**
- Riding Boots (must cover ankle and have a heel)
- Helmet – ASTM-SEI approved and properly fitted to size
- XC Protective Vest these are required by Eventful Acres
- Medical Arm Band or bracelet
- Gloves – strongly recommended

Horse Feed and Stall equipment:

Hay – enough for 3 days and the ride home- it is always better to have too much!

Salt block

Grain and Supplements (must be clearly marked and in a closed container. Check Horse Management Handbook.)

Grain tub (if giving grain or supplements)

Hay feed tub or Hay Bag or may feed on ground if desired (ground is dirt)

2 Water Buckets: 5gal buckets with twine & double ended snaps

1 Stall Card (**all** information must be on card including picture) Please refer to USPC web site for Stall Card information.

1 Feed chart (all information must be filled out on the feed chart and posted where your horse's feed will be stored)

Wheelbarrow or Mucking bucket w/wheels (these may be shared)

Manure fork

Leaf rake
