Sierra Pacific Regional Camp

July 12 – 14, 2019

Dear Members,

We are pleased that you want to participate in this year's Sierra Pacific Regional Camp at Eventful Acres on July 12-14. We are hard at work creating a fun and exceptional learning experience for all who attend. Regional Camp this year is focused on helping D3 and above riders get ready for their next certification. We have brought together some top-notch instructors who are ready to help each rider do that. Here are some of the details:

The Schedule:

Camp begins Thursday with arrival between 4 and 5:30 pm. There will be no riding on Thursday as part of camp. Friday and Saturday will consist of morning and afternoon lessons, HM and extra activities, including after dinner. Sunday morning we will wrap up with an opportunity to showcase what you have learned.

Please plan to arrive on Thursday in time to settle in and join everyone at 6 pm for dinner and our first camp meeting where we will go over logistics and have a chance to meet fellow campers.

Sunday is a half-day at camp. We hope to have everyone on the road no later than 2 pm and will provide the fixings for bag lunches at Sunday breakfast to make the trip home a bit easier.

Lessons:

Everyone will have 2 group lessons each day both Saturday and Sunday. We will accommodate dressage track riders and will try to accommodate hunt seat riders who would rather show jump than do cross-country.

Please indicate on your registration paperwork whether you would like to do flat or jump in the afternoon and if you would rather show jump than do cross-country.

HM Activities:

In addition to mounted lessons, each day there will be additional learning opportunities covering a number of certification appropriate topics. Please be sure to indicate on your application any particular topics you would like to have covered.

Horse and Rider Fitness:

Participating in camp is a rigorous 3 days. Mounts and their riders **MUST** be fit enough to ride for up to 3 hours per day. Bringing a mount to camp that is not fit enough is both a health and safety issue. Horses showing signs of distress or lack of conditioning during lessons may be excused.

Extras:

There will be a movie night on Saturday evening and a chance to relax and share ideas and experiences with fellow campers.

Meals:

Camp fees include 9 meals, from dinner on Thursday evening through a bagged lunch on Sunday. Efforts will be made to accommodate special dietary needs communicated in advance.

People Accommodations:

Most campers at Eventful Acres choose to bring their own tents. There are bathrooms (some with running water, some outhouses) on the property, as well as separate shower facilities. Arrangements can be made with our Eventful Acres hosts for those who wish to bring their own RVs.

Horse Accommodations:

Eventful Acres has pipe panel paddocks for the horses. We are including 2 bags of shavings in the camp fees. This is typically sufficient for horses most horses with this length of stay. If you need more, there will be additional bags for purchase, or you can bring your own.

Non-Riders Attending Camp:

Parents and other family members are welcome and encouraged to attend Pony Club Camp. Your fee for the weekend will include meals and accommodations (a nominal charge paid to the facility).

2. The undersigned Owner/Rider/Student/Parent or Guardian shall assume all responsibility and risk arising out of engaging in or participating in equestrian activities at Eventful Acres. The undersigned Owner/Rider/Student/Parent or Guardian shall hold Eventful Acres, Rod and Karen Hisken, employee their agents or family members harmless from all damages or liability for and injury to person, injury to horse, damage to personal property or for wrongful injury or death caused by negligence.

3. The undersigned Owner/Rider/Student/Parent or Guardian does for him/herself, his/her heirs, executors, administrators, an assigns hereby release, waive, discharge and relinquish any action or cause of action, aforesaid, which may hereafter arise for him/herself and for his/her estate and agrees that under any claim for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death against Rod Hisken, Karen Hisken, employee, their agents or any family member for any of said cause of action, whether the same shall arise by negligence of any person otherwise.
